



Use the notes already given as a guide, and try to make use of some triplet groups. Be sure that each bar equals the correct number of beats. Have fun!






**Tenuto** – Hold a note for its full value.




**b** Flat sign - A flat lowers a note by one semitone.

I  $^{1\!\!/_2}$  - Between  $1^{\rm st}$  and  $2^{\rm nd}$  position






**Mezzo staccato** – Short, detached notes played within a slur. **Tenuto slur** – Smooth, slightly detached notes played within a slur.

Col legno – Playing with the wooden (stick) part of the bow.
Sul tasto – Play over the fingerboard. Ponticello –Play on or near the bridge.
Non pont. – No longer play on or near the bridge.
Tremolo J = Repeat the note as fast as possible for the note's full duration.
A tempo – Return to the original speed. Sul E – Play entirely on the E string.
Gliss. (glissando) – Slide your finger to the next note.


