

Minim - Hold a minim for 2 beats.




Crotchet - Hold a crotchet for 1 beat.






# Sharp sign – Raises a note by one semitone.

On the next page, you will see a *sharp* sign used as part of the *key signature*.




**Key signature** – The group of sharps or flats that appears at the beginning of a *staff* indicating which *key* the piece is in. This piece begins and ends on G. **G Major** is a key signature with one sharp (F<sup>#</sup>).




**D Major** is a key signature with two sharps ( $F^{\sharp}$  and  $C^{\sharp}$ ).

 $3^{rd}$  finger on the A string - 'C $^{\sharp\prime}$ '






**A Major** is a key signature with three sharps  $(F^{\sharp}, C^{\sharp} \text{ and } G^{\sharp})$ .


